Easter Pennant Banner Instructions

Create a festive and charming Easter display using your printable pennant banner with these simple steps:

1. Print the Banner Pages

- For best results, print on white cardstock to ensure durability and vibrant colors.
- Use your home printer or a local print shop.

2. Cut Out the Pennant Shapes

- Carefully trim each pennant along the outer edges using scissors or a paper trimmer.
- Take your time for clean, even edges.

3. Punch Holes for Hanging

- Use a hole punch to create two holes at the top corners of each pennant—one on the left and one on the right.

4. String the Banner

- Thread a length of ribbon, twine, or yarn through the holes in each pennant, arranging them in your desired order.
- Leave extra length at both ends for tying or taping during display.

5. Display Your Banner

- Hang the completed banner across a mantle, wall, doorway, or party table to add a festive Easter touch to your space. Make sure it is safely placed based on your student's age.
